- Automatic handling of secure PDF encryption, compatible with Adobe's latest release of Acrobat 9. Generating 100% native PDF files opened in the free Adobe Reader and in Internet Explorer or other Web browsers, without the end-user requirement to download and install a third-party viewer to open the secured PDF.
- Programmatic definition of encryption keys in NetIS server and not inside the documents, leaving no "backdoor" of breaking the files encryption (Using secure SSL protocols and RC4 with a 128-bit key encryption) to balance the need for broad compatibility with the diversity of Adobe Reader versions and operating system configurations.
- Like in HTML protection, access control to the PDF files would include expiration, concurrent-usage limitations, copying, saving and printing restrictions, integrating seamlessly with customers' firewall, workflows and NetIS based applications.
